Excerpts from 33 revealing interviews with artists, critics, and dealers, conducted by Billy Klu?ver and Julie Martin, offer unique personal insight into the era's creative milieu. Taken together, the book's essays and interviews provide a distinctly new assessment of how downtown New York's fertile environment nurtured an innovative art scene.
